

## CASCADE CREST 100 DRIVING DIRECTIONS

### TACOMA PASS

From exit 62 go south (left if coming from Easton) on FS 54. Follow 3.1 miles to intersection of FS 41. Go left on FS 41 for 7.6 miles. Take a right on FS 52 at the well-marked turn to Tacoma Pass. Aid station is 1 mile up on the left. DRIVE PAST AND PARK ON LEFT. DO NOT PARK BEFORE STATION.

### STAMPEDE PASS

Take I-90 to exit 62. Head south on FS 54 for 4.5 miles. The aid station will be on your left.

### MEADOW MOUNTAIN

Exit 62 off of I-90. Head south on FS 54. After 1 mile take a right on FS 5480 following signs for Lost Lake. Take FS 5480 for 1.6 miles. Take a left on FS 5483. Stay on 5483 for approx 5 miles. You will see a sign for Meadow Pass/ PCT to the left – do not take that turn. Approx. 1 mile after that sign you will come to an intersection with two bright orange arrows pointing right... ignore your urge to follow the arrows and go to the LEFT. Aid station is just down the road on the right. PARK BEFORE THE AID STATION. THERE IS A SMALL CLEARING WHERE CARS CAN TURN AROUND. DO NOT PARK IN THE TURN OUT. TURN AROUND AND PARK ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE ROAD (AS YOU FACE AWAY FROM THE AID STATION) AND WALK UP 250 YARDS TO THE STATION.

### OLALLIE MEADOWS

Exit 54 (Hyak) off of I-90. Head south. Go straight, through two stop signs and take a left on Hyak Drive East. You will go downhill and then around to the right and past a number of houses. After 0.7 miles you will pass through a gate and wind to the right around a sewage treatment plant. Then the road turns to dirt. Stay on this road (FS 9070) for 4.5 miles to the aid station. PARKING IS LIMITED HERE. Be prepared to park before or after the aid station and walk up the road.

### HYAK

Exit 54 from I-90. Coming from Easton, the aid station is immediately to the right at the bottom of the exit ramp. This is a loud, enthusiastic aid station. If you plan to sleep while waiting for your runner bring ear plugs 😊

### KACHESS LAKE

Exit 62 off of I-90. Head north on Lake Kachess Road for 5.1 miles to a “T” intersection. Take a left. Go 0.4 miles uphill on a dirt road to the next intersection. There is a large information sign directly ahead of you here. Turn right at the sign and head 0.2 miles on FS 4930 to the aid station in a campsite on your left.

### MINERAL CREEK

I-90 Eastbound to exit 80. Take a left over the freeway. Take SR 903 towards Roslyn. Follow SR 903 for 18.1 miles heading through Roslyn and Ronald (beware of speed traps). At the Cooper Lake intersection take a left onto FS 46 and follow for 7 miles to the intersection with No Name Ridge Road. Park here and wait for your runner or walk down to the aid station on the road (2 miles).

### FRENCH CABIN

Difficult road conditions. Cars should have good clearance and be fairly narrow. WIDE SUVs AND TRUCKS WILL NOT MAKE IT THROUGH THIS ROAD due to a landslide that has partially blocked the road on the uphill side. From Easton take Sparks Road to FS Kachess Dam Road (FS 4818). Stay on FS 4818 for 6.2 miles to the intersection with FS 4824. Take a right on FS 4824 and follow it uphill for 4.8 miles to the aid station.

### SILVER CREEK

Take exit 70 from I-90 and take a left onto West Sparks Rd. (the access road just north of I-90). After 0.5 miles take a right on Kachess Dam Road (FS 4818). Take FS 4818 1.5 miles then take a right on a road signed to trail # 1315. Drive 0.5 miles and park. It is a short (100yd) walk in to the aid station.

### START / FINISH

Exit 71 from I-90. Head south 3 blocks over the railroad tracks. The fire station is on the left.
